		<p>Cleaning</p> <p>Identify hard surface areas and reduce the risk of contact by visitors. Inform all visitors to take appropriate care when touching hard surfaces such as door handles, light switches, and court gate sliders & to sanitise their hands after use.</p> <p>Cleaning materials relocated to outside storage bin for use by all.</p>	<p>The Club has introduced the following measure to reduce the risk of contact with hard surfaces:</p> <p>Gates to be kept open where possible.</p> <p>Coaches & committee members to take an active part in cleaning hard surfaces when on site.</p> <p>Club guidelines/checklist & booking confirmation advises visitors to limit contact with hard surfaces & to use hand sanitiser after contact.</p> <p>Net winders NOT to be used by members.
